

AMENDATORY AGREEMENT

AMENDATORY AGREEMENT entered into between the PAN AMERICAN HEALTH ORGANIZATION (hereinafter referred to as the “**Beneficiary**”) and the INTER-AMERICAN DEVELOPMENT BANK (hereinafter referred to as the “**Bank**”, and together with the Beneficiary, as the “**Parties**”).

ARTICLE ONE

The Parties agree to amend the Nonreimbursable Technical Cooperation Agreement No. ATN/JF-18181-RG “Supporting the Malaria Elimination Efforts in Mesoamerica while Addressing the COVID-19 Pandemic” entered into between the Parties on May 17, 2021, as amended from time to time (hereinafter referred to as the “**Agreement**”), in the manner and to the extent set forth below.

1. The Budget included in Section 3.01 of the Annex to the Agreement is amended to increase the amount required for Rapid diagnostic tests and decrease the amount required for PPE for malaria personnel, and shall read as follows:

ARTICLE THREE


The Parties hereby agree that all other provisions of the Agreement, as amended, remain in full force and effect.
