Status Update

This cooperation is part of an exchange of knowledge on urban planning in historic centers, between municipalities of Paraguay and Chile, which seeks to publicize good practices, programs, projects, administrative, legal and regulatory processes, linked to heritage, in the context of the intense urban transformations that medium-sized cities have undergone. With this, contribute to technical and professional development, delivering different tools to the four municipalities of Paraguay, Asunción, Concepción, Pilar and Villarrica. The three cities visited were Santiago, Chillan and Valparaiso, in which the main activities consisted of meetings with public and private stakeholders, visits to emblematic projects and initiatives in urban and heritage areas, according to governance, size and diverse population. In this sense, after the Technical Cooperation between both countries, it can be concluded the relevance of the exchange between different actors that work on the development of cities and heritage, at a national and international level, which allows learning from experiences, reflecting and have more technical tools and knowledge in various fields, to address sustainable development strategies. It is of vital importance to be able to articulate different actors, in the public, private and academic spheres, so that the advances, guidelines and/or projects are not only framed within the government, but rather that the capacity and knowledge is distributed among all, and to it is necessary to involve the general public.

1 . Mayor conocimiento sobre el Abordaje a Centros Históricos entre Municipios de Paraguay y Chile.

This Chile Paraguay mission allowed dialogue around heritage and the need to build a Network of Heritage City Historic Centers in Paraguay and on a Latin American scale, where it is possible to generate brotherhood and link professionals, who contribute to the exploration of possible solutions against the existing challenges of each municipality or country. The search for advice from trained people allows education and subsequent installation of capacities in the teams, creating networks and agreements between different actors, public and private, which allow initiatives and projects to advance, independent of the authorities.
