The Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) has received support totaling €260.596 from the Spanish Technical General Cooperation Trust Fund for the financing of consulting services draft a number of constitutional amendments, laws, and policies in support of the Modernization of the Peruvian Justice System Reform Process

The services include the preparation of: (i) legislative drafts for the Constitutional Title on the Judiciary, Organics Laws for the Judiciary and Judicial Council; (ii) an institutional design to improve the administration of the prosecution office at the court level; (iii) curricula for training the penitentiary systems staff; (iv) a new protocol for treatment of inmates; (v) a new system for the execution of penalties; and (vi) a new policy to fight organized crime. To achieve this objective, the activities will include: preparation of the corresponding drafts and the participation in or conducting of consensus building seminars with the necessary stakeholders. The consulting services will be required for approximately 16 consultants/month, within a period not to exceed of nine from the initiation of the consultancy. Approximately, half of the work should be performed in situ.

The IDB now invites eligible consulting services to express their interest in providing the services. Interested firms must submit evidence that they are qualified to perform the services (brochures, description of similar assignments, experience in similar conditions, availability of appropriate skills among staff, etc.). Consultants may associate to enhance their qualifications. A number of 75 per cent of the amount approved to finance the project is tied to provision of services by Spanish consultants. Up to 25 per cent can be used to finance consulting services provided by companies or individuals from the beneficiary country.

Consulting services will be selected in accordance with the procedures set out in the IDB's *Policies for the Selection and Contracting of Consultants financed by the Inter-American Development Bank*, current edition. The evaluation committee will apply the quality- and cost-based selection method.
