The Government of Guyana has received a financing from the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) to pay part of the cost of the Georgetown Water Supply and Sewerage Program II. It is intended that part of the proceeds of this financing be applied to eligible payments under the contract for the procurement of contractors to supply and install a water distribution system in Georgetown.

Guyana Water Incorporated (the employer) now invites interested parties to present their respective proposals in sealed envelopes, with proof of their legal, technical and financial capacity for the supply or construction.

The works consist of the furnishing the necessary labor, materials, equipment and services for the construction and completion for rehabilitation and sectorization of the water distribution system in three zones within the Georgetown services area - Zones W2, W4 and W14. In these rehabilitated areas, all service connections are to be replaced and consumer meters installed on each service. At the same time, facilities are to be installed to permit isolation of the zones and metering of flow into and out of the zone.

Interested parties may obtain further information, including eligibility to participate, and may inspect the bidding documents at the first address below, as of 31 December 2002.

A complete set of prequalification documents may be purchased by interested parties by submitting a written application to the second address below and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of G\$ 15,000. The method of payment will be cash, certified check, or bank draft payable to the Guyana Water Incorporated, at the first address below. It will not be necessary to make the request in person to receive a complete set of the prequalification documents, since these can be sent by mail.

Proposals must be received at the second office below on or before 0900 hours, on 18 February 2003. It will not be necessary to submit proposals in person, since they may be sent by mail. However, the employer is not responsible for proposals not received thereof on or before the time and date specified for the reception of proposals, in which case they will be rejected and returned unopened.

Proposals will be opened at a public ceremony, in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend, at 0900 hours on 18 February 2003, at the offices of the Central Tender Board.
