The Government of Guyana has received a loan from the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) toward the cost of Georgetown Water Supply and Sewerage Programme II, and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this loan to payments under the contract for Shelter Belt Water Treatment Plant Rehabilitation.

Guyana Water Incorporated now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for the Procurement of Filter Media and Ancillaries. The supply period will be 180 days after the award of the contract.

Bidding will be conducted through the international competitive bidding (ICB) procedures specified in the IDB's Policies for the Procurement of Works and Goods financed by the Inter-American Development Bank, and is open to all bidders from eligible source countries as defined in the Policies.

Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information from, inspect and acquire the bidding documents at the Customer Relations and Commercial Services Office, at the first address below, between 0800 and 1630 hours, Monday to Thursday, and between 0800 and 1530 hours on Friday. The Guyana Water Inc. officers in charge are Messrs. Kevin Horn and Ronald Rajnarine. They may be contacted by phone or fax.

Qualifications requirements include: Suppliers with at least five years of Technical, Financial and Legal experience in supplies of this nature. A margin of preference for eligible national contractors shall not be applied. Additional details are provided in the bidding documents.

A complete set of bidding documents, in English, may be purchased by interested bidders on the submission of a written application to the above office and upon payment of a non refundable fee of 5,000 GYD or US\$ 25. Bidding documents may also be downloaded from the Web site below.

The method of payment will be by certified check to Guyana Water Incorporated for hard copies.

Bids must be delivered to The Secretary, National Procurement and Tender Administration Board, to the second address below on or before 0900 hours, 18 July 2006. Electronic bidding will not be permitted. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend in person at the office of The Secretary, National Procurement and Tender Administration Board, second address below, at 0900 hours, 18 July

2006. All bids must be accompanied by a bid security or bid-securing declaration, as appropriate, of no less than US\$ 5,000 or an equivalent amount in Guyana Dollars.

Bidders registered in Guyana must submit an IRD Compliance indicating that the bidder has met his/her Income Tax obligations and an NIS Compliance indicating that the bidder has met his/her NIS obligations.
