4. Develop and Implement a Comprehensive Training Scheme for the Guyana Police Force.
5. Institutional Modernization of the Ministry of Home Affairs and its Agencies;
6. Development of M & E Framework for the CSP Programme.

(a) Both the Technical and Financial Proposals should be in inner but separate envelopes bearing the name and address of the bidder and are then enclosed in an outer envelope which should state the "title" of the Consultancy for which the bid is being offered.

(b) The proposals must be addressed to the Project Coordinator, Citizen Security Programme, Lot 'MM' Ogle, East Coast Demerara and marked on the top right-hand

corner of the envelope “the name of the programme and the description of the bid, including the words ‘do not open before 9:00 hrs on the 19th day of August 2008.’”

The proposals must be deposited in the Tender box of the Citizen Security Programme, Lot ‘MM’ Ogle, East Coast Demerara, no later than 9:00 hrs on the 19th day of August 2008 and the technical proposals will be opened at a public ceremony on the 19th day of August 2008, in the presence of those Bidders’ or their representative who choose to attend.

Valid compliance certificates from the Guyana Revenue Authority (GRA) and National Insurance Scheme (NIS) and TIN Number must accompany bids from local bidders in the name of the company submitting the bid.
