Bidding document can be purchased by interested bidders upon payment of a non refundable fee of US\$ 75.00 or equivalent in the name of Citizen Security Programme. The method of payment will be by manager's cheque or bank draft.

Interested bidders can obtain further information on and uplift a copy of the of Tender Document at the following address between 9 to 15:30 hours, from Monday to Fridays, at the Citizen Security Programme Office, Lot 'MM' Ogle, East Coast Demerara, Guyana.

Both the Technical and Financial Proposals should be in inner but separate envelopes bearing the name and address of the bidder and are then enclosed in an outer envelope which should state the "title" of the Consultancy for which the bid is being offered.

The proposals must be addressed to the Chairman, National Procurement and Tender Administration Board, Main and Urquhart Streets, Georgetown and marked on the top

right-hand corner of the envelope “the name of the programme and the description of the bid, including the words ‘do not open before 9:00 hrs on December 30, 2008.’”

The proposals must be deposited in the Tender box of the National Procurement and Tender, Main and Urquhart Streets, Georgetown, no later than 9 hours on December 30, 2008 and the technical proposals will be opened at a public ceremony, in the presence of those Bidders’ or their representative who choose to attend.

Valid compliance certificates from the Guyana Revenue Authority (GRA) and National Insurance Scheme (NIS) and TIN Number must accompany bids from local bidders in the name of the company submitting the bid.

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
