Consumers International has received financing in the amount equivalent to US \$450,000 from the Multilateral Investment Fund (MIF), and it intends to apply part of the proceeds to payments for goods, works, related services and consulting services to be procured under the project Promotion of Consumer Protection in the Caribbean. Bidding will be governed by the Inter-American Development Bank's eligibility rules and procedures.

The main objective of this project is to strengthen consumer protection policies in the Caribbean by reinforcing the capacity of non-government consumer organizations and government agencies, and by increasing consumers' awareness about their rights, in particular within the Banking and Credit sector. Individual consultants, consulting firms and a small amount of office equipment will be procured under the project.

Procurement processes of contracts financed by the Inter-American Development Bank will be conducted in accordance with the [Policies for Procurement of Goods and Works financed by the Inter-American Development Bank](#) (current edition), and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the policies. Consulting services will be selected and contracted in accordance with the [Policies for the Selection and Contracting of Consultants financed by the Inter-American Development Bank](#) (current edition).

Specific procurement notices for contracts to be bid under the IDB's international competitive bidding (ICB) procedures, will be published as they become available. For consulting services expected to cost an amount equivalent to US\$200,000 or more, a request for expressions of interest contracts will be advertised in [UN Development Business](#) and [IDB's](#) Web Site.
