

# Definition of Non-Covered Prescription Drug Services



## International Plan

The Prescription Drug Plan does not pay for:

- » Experimental drugs or substances not approved by the relevant national authorities where your treatment occurs (e.g., the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) in the case of the U.S)
- » Drugs labeled, “Caution – Limited by Federal/National Law to Investigational Use”.
- » Over-the-counter drugs.
- » Prescription vitamins, except prenatal vitamins, certain vitamins that are part of cancer treatment or other treatments of other critical medical conditions, and vitamins in large dosages associated with major deficiencies of those vitamins.
- » Herbal or food/nutritional supplements.
- » Any medicinal product which does not contain chemical ingredients. Pill/supplements, whose composition is made of natural ingredients, will not be covered regardless of how it is labeled in different countries.
- » Homeopathic products, pills, and medicines.
- » Chinese medicine.
- » Cosmetic prescriptions.
- » Phytotherapy.
- » Hair growth stimulants, hair tonics, and special shampoos.
- » Special toothpastes.
