The Government of Guyana has received financing from the Inter-American Development Bank toward the cost of the Mahaica Rosignol Road Rehabilitation Project. It is intended that part of the proceeds of this financing will be applied to eligible payments under the contract for the design of the southern approach road.

The Government of Guyana, acting by and through the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Public Works and Communications, Wight's Lane, Kingston, invites sealed bids from interested parties, with proof of their legal, technical and financial capacity for the provision of consulting services for the design of 14.7 km of new roads.

Interested bidders may obtain further information including eligibility to participate and may purchase a set of bidding documents by written communication or by applying in person to the office of the Works Services Group, at the first address below, between 0800 and 1600 hours except on public holidays and on payment of a non-fundable sum of US\$ 40 or G\$ 8,000. Parties who request that the pre-qualification documents be sent to them will be required to pay in advance for this service.

Bids must be placed in an envelope, and marked on the outside at the top right hand corner "Pre-Qualification for Procurement of Consultants for Final Design Southern Approach". And on the left hand corner the name and address of the bidder. The envelope should be sealed and addressed to the second address below.

Bids must be placed in the Tender Box of the National Board of Procurement and Tender Administration at the second address below at or before 0900 hours, Tuesday, 18 January 2005. It will not be necessary to submit bids in person since they may be sent by mail. However, the employer is not responsible for bids not received thereof on or before the time and date specified for reception of bids. Late bids will be rejected and returned unopened.

Bids will be opened at a public ceremony in the presence of those bidders or their representatives who choose to attend at 0900 hours, Tuesday, 18 January 2005, in the Conference Room of the National Board of Procurement and Tender Administration Ministry of Finance, at the second address below.
