Invitation for Bids No. 10 /2005 No. 1

The Government of Guyana has received financing from the Inter-American Development Bank toward the cost of Urban Development Program. It is intended that part of the proceeds of this financing be applied to eligible payments under the contracts for consultants to design and supervise the works described in the following lots:

▪ Lots 10(a) and 10(b) combined:

--Lot 10 (a) – Rehabilitation of emergency roads and drains, North Ruimveldt, West Ruimveldt and Festival City

--Lot 10 (b) – Rehabilitation of emergency roads and drains, South Ruimveldt Gardens and Park

▪ Lots 10(c), 10(d), 10(e) combined:

--Lot 10 (c) – Rehabilitation of emergency roads and drains, Albouystown, West La Penitence and Castello Housing Scheme

--Lot 10 (d) – Rehabilitation of emergency roads and drains, Tucville, South Ruimveldt Gardens and Charlestown

--Lot 10 (e) –Rehabilitation of emergency roads and drains, other wards

The Government of Guyana, acting through the Ministry of Local Government and Regional Development, Fort Street, Kingston, Georgetown, Guyana (employer) now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the contracting of the above mentioned works.

The major work items include — but are not limited to — the design and supervision of the following rehabilitation works:

- Asphaltic concrete, DBST and concrete roads
- Desilting of earthen and reinforced concrete roadside drains
- Adjacent road shoulders

Eligible bidders may obtain further information, including eligibility to participate, may inspect the bidding documents at the address below as of 14 November 2005

Interested eligible bidders may purchase a set of bidding documents by submitting a written application or applying in person between 0830 and 1600 hours, Monday through Friday, except on public holidays, and upon payment of a non-reimbursable fee of G\$ 5,000 in cash or manager's check payable to the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Local Government and Regional Development. It will not be necessary to make the request in person to receive a complete set of bidding documents, since these can be sent by mail to the Project Coordinator, Urban Development Program, at the first address below.

Bidders may submit proposals for lots 10(a) and 10 (b) combined and/or lots 10(c), 10(d) and 10(e) combined. Each combination of lots shall be evaluated and awarded individually, not globally.

Bids must be placed in a sealed envelope and marked on the outside at the top right hand corner "Consultancy for the Design and Supervision of Phase 2 Civil Works - Lot 10 - Rehabilitation of Emergency Roads and Drains Georgetown" and delivered to the Chairman, National Procurement and Tender and Tender Administration, Ministry of Finance, at the second address below.

Bids must be placed in the tender box of the Ministry of Finance at the same address before 0900 hours on Tuesday, 13 December 2005. It will not be necessary to submit bids in person since they may be sent by mail. However, the employer is not responsible for bids not received thereof before the time and date

specified for reception of bids. Late bids will be rejected and returned unopened. However, it is advisable that these bids be sent early to avoid transportation delays.

Bids will be opened at a public ceremony in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend immediately thereafter in the conference room of the National Procurement and Tender Administration Board, Ministry of Finance.

Bidders registered in Guyana must submit a Guyana Revenue Authority compliance certificate indicating that they have met the income tax obligations for the three years preceding the closing date of bid, and a NIS compliance certificate indicating that they have met the NIS obligations for the month immediately preceding the month of tender.

Interested bidders may attend a site visit and pre-bid meeting. The site visit will start from City Hall, Mayor and City Council, on 18 November 2005, at 0900 hours. The pre-bid meeting will be held on 18 November 2005 at 1430 hours at the office of the Urban Development Program, first address below.
