The Government of the Co-operative Republic of Guyana has received financing from the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) for the Unserved Areas Electrification Programme (UAEP). It is intended that part of this financing be applied to payments under the UAEP's Grid Connections Programme for the Procurement of Goods for Electrical Distribution System.

The Guyana Power & Light (GPL) Inc. serves as the implementation agency for the project and now invites sealed Bids from eligible suppliers for the Procurement of: Wallaba poles, Cross arms & Sleepers for Electrical Distribution System.

Bidding will be conducted through the International competitive bidding (ICB) procedures, specified in the Procurement Act 2003, and is open to all suppliers from member countries of the IADB.

Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information and specifications from the first address below.

All bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security of 2% of the Tendered Amount.

Bidding documents can be inspected and purchased by interested bidders upon payment of a non-refundable fee of G\$ 5000 in the name of the Guyana Power and Light Inc. at our Main Street Office, and uplifted from the second address below between the hours of 8:30 am and 4:00 pm. The method of payment will be by company check or manager's check.

Bids must be placed in sealed envelopes and addressed to the third address below and deposited in the Tender Box before 09.00 hours on 15th April, 2008, and marked on the top right hand corner of the envelope "Bid for the Procurement of Wallaba poles, Cross arms & Sleepers for Electrical Distribution System – UAEP Department," including the words 'do not open before 15th April, 2008'.

Late Bids will be rejected. Bids will be opened in the presence of the suppliers' representatives who choose to attend in person at 09:00 hours on the closing date. All Bids from local suppliers must be accompanied by valid GRA and NIS Compliance Certificates. GPL reserves the right to accept or reject any or all quotations at any time during the procurement process.
