The Guyana Tourism Authority (GTA) on submission of the attached Cluster Development Plan (CDP) for your consideration, hereby commits to providing US\$38,319 as counterpart cash contribution, which includes contributions from the tourism private sector in the South Rupununi circuit as noted in section D7 of our proposal and in Annex 1.
