The Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) intends to finance the supervisory consultant services described below under the Loan: LO-1803/SF-GY: Transport Infrastructure Rehabilitation Programme (TIRP), Reconstruction of Roadway Structures-Lot B Project.

The scope of the civil works involves the rehabilitation/reconstruction of Culverts between Timehri and Rosignol. The works includes, but is not limited to, the following activities: (i) relocation, protection and re-instatement of existing utilities; (ii) cofferdam construction and dewatering; (iii) excavation at culvert and bridge locations; (iv) demolition of existing structures and the construction of new structures; (viii) construction of several sluice structures to be integral with culverts; (x) construction of detour roads and detour bridges; (ix) installation of traffic hazard signs at structure locations on shoulders; (x) reinstatement of roadway markings where faded within construction limits; (xi) installation of service ducts; and (xii) traffic management. The estimated construction period is 16 months with a subsequent defect liability period of 12 months.

The Works Services Group now invites eligible consultants to indicate their interest in providing the services. Interested consultants must provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services (brochures, description of similar assignments, experience in similar conditions, availability of appropriate skills among staff, etc.). Consultants may associate to enhance their qualifications.

Consultants will be selected in accordance with the procedures set out in the current edition of the IDB's Guidelines: <I>Policies for the Selection and Contracting of Consultants Financed By the Inter- American Development Bank</I>, GN-2350-7.
