<b>Brazil 2019-2022</b>	<a href="#">GN-2973</a>	The TC is aligned with the country strategy (CS) priority of: (iv) reducing inequality and lack of opportunities by enhancing public policy efficiency. It is also aligned with the CS's crosscutting challenges related to gender and diversity. Also, during the COVID-19 pandemic, the Bank's programming for 2021-2022 will continue to work within this framework, prioritizing the macro-fiscal stability, productivity, and social axes, as it seeks to create employment, support SMEs, aid vulnerable populations, and boost the post-Covid 19 economic recovery.
<b>Chile 2019-2022</b>	<a href="#">GN-2946</a>	The TC is aligned with the CS on two strategic areas: (i) higher investment and productivity and (ii) better quality of life for the population, with emphasis on: improving the health of Chileans, increasing pensions in a sustainable way, increasing connectivity and mobility in urban areas, and (f) promoting resilience to climate related natural disasters. The country is also working on the crosscutting area of gender and diversity.
<b>Panama 2021-2024</b>	<a href="#">GN-3055</a>	The country strategy prioritizes: (ii) improving the delivery of basic services; and (iii) reigniting and diversifying productive activity. It is also closely aligned to Panama's crosscutting issues of gender, diversity, and cultural relevance.
<b>Paraguay 2019-2023</b>	<a href="#">GN-2958</a>	The TC is aligned with the country strategy as it prioritizes: (ii) human capital and living conditions. It will also provide crosscutting support for the challenges relating to (a) gender, diversity, and indigenous populations and (b) urban development.
<b>Trinidad and Tobago (Government Vision 2030)</b>	<a href="#">GN-2888</a>	The TC is closely aligned with the CS and Government's Vision 2030, as it focuses on 3 main pillars: (i) Strengthening Public Institutions and Governance; (ii) Promoting Private Sector Development; and (iii) Fostering Human Development while also addressing Climate Change and Gender.
