Invitation for Bids

The Government of Guyana has received financing from the Inter-American Development Bank toward the cost of the Air Transport Reform Programme (ATRP). It is intended that part of the proceeds be applied to eligible payments under the contract for the rehabilitation of the sewerage system and the construction of a sewage treatment plant at the Cheddi Jagan International Airport (CJIA).

The Government of Guyana, acting through the Ministry of Public Works and Communications, (employer), now invites sealed bid from interested bidders for the construction of a sewage treatment plant at the CJIA.

The works include, among other things:

- Preparation of design, construction and commissioning of a sewage treatment plant and ancillary works (viz. generator hut, fencing and gates to facilities)

The employer invites bidders to present a complete and detailed bid for the works.

Interested firms may obtain further information, including eligibility to participate, and may inspect the bidding documents at the first address below, as of 1 December 2003.

A pre-bid site meeting will be held on 17 December 2003 at the airport's car park in the vicinity of the Lotus Restaurant at 1000 hours.

The qualification questionnaire must be completed and submitted along with the bidding documents. Firms registered in Guyana must include in their bids valid GRA and NIS Certificates of Compliance.

A set of bidding documents may be obtained by any interested firm on the submission of a written application to the Programme Coordinator, ATRP (same address), and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of US\$ 75 or G\$ 15,000. Bidding documents may also be purchased in person between 0800 and 1600 hours, Monday through Friday, except on public holidays.

The method of payment will be cash or a bank draft made payable to the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Public Works and Communications. It will not be necessary to make the request in person to receive the documents, since these can be sent by mail or by courier.

Bids must be placed in a sealed envelope, marked on the top right hand corner "Construction of a Sewage Treatment Plant AT-CJIA BID No. ATRP 14/2003 No. 1", addressed to the Chairman, Central Tender Board (second address below).

Bids must be placed in the tender box of the Central Tender Board at the same address before 0900 hours on Tuesday, 20 January 2004. It will not be necessary to submit bids in person since they may be sent by mail. However, the employer is not responsible for bids not received thereof before the time and date specified. Late bids will be rejected and returned unopened. It is advisable that bids be sent early to avoid transportation delays.

Bids will be opened at a public ceremony, in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend, immediately after 0900 hours on Tuesday, 20 January 2004, in the conference room of the Central Tender Board.

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
