**Invitation for Bids**

The Government of Guyana has received financing from the Inter-American Development Bank toward the cost of the Air Transport Reform Programme (ATRP). It is intended that part of the proceeds be applied to eligible payments under the contract for the rehabilitation of the sewerage system and the construction of a sewage treatment plant at the Cheddi Jagan International Airport (CJIA).

The Government of Guyana, acting through the Ministry of Public Works and Communications, (employer), now invites sealed bid from interested bidders for the rehabilitation of the sewerage system at the CJIA.

The works include, among other things:

- Construction of 18 manholes, two grease traps, 15 inspection boxes and one holding tank for wastewater from aircraft
- Rehabilitation of existing sewer manholes including replacement of 38 manhole covers, raising invert levels, reforming existing inverts to falls and cleaning out manholes
- Flushing out existing sewer lines, which are proposed for reuse in the sewerage system
- Installation of approximately 3,816 m of new sewer lines, both along new alignments and in some instances along the existing alignment, but above the existing sewer lines
- Sealing up disused sewer lines and manholes
- Construction and commissioning of a sewage treatment plant to be executed by a specialist sub-contractor to be selected by the employer

The employer invites bidders to present a complete and detailed bid for the works.

Interested firms may obtain further information, including eligibility to participate, and may inspect the bidding documents at the first address below, as of 1 December 2003.

A pre-bid site meeting will be held on 17 December 2003 at the airport's car park in the vicinity of the Lotus Restaurant at 1000 hours.

Firms registered in Guyana must include in their bids valid GRA and NIS Certificates of Compliance.

A set of bidding documents may be obtained by any interested firm on the submission of a written application to the Programme Coordinator, ATRP (same address), and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of US\$ 100 or G\$ 20,000. Bidding documents may also be purchased in person between 0800 and 1600 hours, Monday through Friday, except on public holidays.

The method of payment will be cash or a bank draft made payable to the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Public Works and Communications. It will not be necessary to make the request in person to receive the documents, since these can be sent by mail or by courier.

Bids must be placed in a sealed envelope, marked on the top right hand corner "Rehabilitation of the Sewerage System – CJIA BID No. ATRP 13/2003 No. 1", addressed to the Chairman, Central Tender Board (second address below).

Bids must be placed in the tender box of the Central Tender Board at the same address before 0900 hours on Tuesday, 20 January 2004. It will not be necessary to submit bids in person since they may be sent by mail. However, the employer is not responsible for bids not received thereof before the time and

date specified. Late bids will be rejected and returned unopened. It is advisable that bids be sent early to avoid transportation delays.

Bids will be opened at a public ceremony, in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend, immediately after 0900 hours on Tuesday, 20 January 2004, in the conference room of the Central Tender Board.

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
