Abstract: PURCHASE OF COMPUTERS AND SOFTWARE

Invitation for Bids No. ATRP-4/2004 No.1

The Government of Guyana has secured financing from the Inter-American Development Bank toward the cost of the Air Transport Reform Programme (ATRP). It is intended that part of the financing proceeds be applied to eligible payments under the contract for the purchase of computers and software for the Cheddi Jagan International Airport.

The Government of Guyana, acting through the Ministry of Public Works and Communications, now invites sealed bid from interested eligible bidders for the:

- Lot 1: Supply of computers, printer, UPS and servers and networking of computers – Lot 1
- Lot 2: Supply and installation of accounting software such as ACCPAC software or equal, equivalent or similar accounting package to computers and training of CJIA personnel
- Lot 3: Supply and installation of a computerized security card system
- Lot 4: Supply and installation of computerized maintenance management software such as TMA WorkGroup or equal, equivalent or similar maintenance management software to computers and training of CJIA personnel

Tenderers may submit bids for an individual lot, all lots or a combination of lots.

Interested firms may obtain further information, including eligibility to participate, and may inspect the bidding documents at the address below as of Monday, 15 March 2004, and may purchase a set of bidding documents by written communication or by applying in person between 0800 and 1600 hours, Monday through Friday (except on public holidays) and upon payment of a non-reimbursable amount of G\$ 7,000 or US\$ 35 to the office of the Programme Coordinator, ATRP, at the first address below.

The method of payment will be cash or a bank draft made payable to the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Public Works and Communications. It will not be necessary to make the request in person to receive a complete set of the bidding documents, since these can be sent by mail or courier.

Bids must be accompanied by a security, in an acceptable form, of no less than G\$ 100,000 or US\$ 500 per lot.

Bids must be placed in an envelope, marked on the outside at the top right hand corner "Computers and Software for CJIA BID No. ATRP-4/2004 No. 1", along with the lot(s) being tendered for. The envelope should be sealed and addressed to the Chairman, Central Tender Board (second address below).

Bids must be placed in the tender box at the Central Tender Board (same address) before 0900 hours on Tuesday, 20 April 2004. It will not be necessary to submit the proposals in person, since they may be sent by mail or by courier. However, the employer is not responsible for bids not received thereof before the time and date specified for reception, in which case they will be rejected and returned to the bidder.

Valid NIS and GRA certificates of compliance must accompany bids for firms registered in Guyana.

Bids will be opened at a public ceremony immediately after 0900 hours on Tuesday, 20 April 2004, in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend, in the conference room of the Central Tender Board.

Firms that previously purchased documents and are interested in tendering can uplift documents by the submission of the receipt.

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
