The Government of Jamaica (GOJ) has secured a loan from the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) to finance the Primary Education Support Project (PESP). One component of the project is for the construction of new, replacement and extension of primary schools throughout the island. These schools are to be provided with furniture and equipment at the end of construction. Construction on the first set of schools (2) will be completed by December 2006.

The GOJ now invites eligible firms from IDB member countries to submit tenders for the supply of furniture and equipment for schools under construction. Furniture and equipment are as follows:

- Desks
- Chairs
- Filing cabinets
- Cupboards
- Tables
- Day beds
- Magazine racks
- Catalogue cabinets
- Metal lockers
- Danish settees

Interested firms and eligible bidders may purchase the tender documents at a cost of J\$ 1,000. The tender documents, along with specifications, will be available from 22 August to 2 October 2006. Local firms must be registered with the National Contracts Committee and must be able to submit a current Tax Compliant Certificate. Clarification or information may be obtained from the Project Manager, PESP, at the address below.

Applications must be delivered to the address below at or before 1500 hours on 3 October 2006. Tender opening will take place at 1505 hours on the same date of delivery. Late applications will not be considered under any circumstances.
