GENERAL DESCRIPTION: The objective of this nonreimbursable technical cooperation is to assist the government of Peru develop and implement a Social Stabilization Plan that will extend the benefits of the economic stabilization and adjustment program to the poorest segments of the population. The specific objectives of the project are to: (a) provide support for the start-up and operation to the technical team responsible for designing and developing the Social Stabilization Plan; and (b) provide the team with a database and information system on natural resources and infrastructure.

The design of the Social Stabilization Plan will entail: (a) analyzing the current situation with respect to levels of poverty and the public and private institutions concerned with social action; (b) analyzing the conditions of infrastructure and natural resources; (c) evaluating successful experiences in programs to combat poverty; (d) designing and formulating a social reform strategy (including objectives, principles, main components) to combat poverty; (e) making proposals under the plan that are compatible with the current economic program; (f) analyzing

the institutional, budgetary and fiscal requirements of the new strategy; and (g) working out a tentative timetable for implementing the plan.

**CONSULTANTS:** The Social Stabilization Plan will be developed by a multidisciplinary technical team made up of 24 consultants, eight international and 16 local, for a total of 204 consultant-months. The areas of specialization include: social development, macro-economics, public-sector social expenditure, economic geography, poverty studies, institutional and local development, natural-resources data analysis and social statistics and communication.
