The Cooperative Republic of Guyana Preparation of a Justice Modernization Program (GY-T1005)

Technical Assistance for Institutional Assessment of Justice Sector and Implementation Plans

The Inter-American Development Bank intends to engage consultants to undertake the design of a Justice Modernization Program in Guyana and to assist the Office of the Chief Justice of Guyana to identify a roadmap of modernization by classifying and prioritizing the necessary actions for a comprehensive justice sector reforms. The assignment is financed through the Bank's Fund for Special Operations (FSO).

The overall objective of the services is to assist the Government of Guyana (GOG) and the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) in obtaining a clear vision of the main goals and concrete actions that a comprehensive modernization justice sector program would require in Guyana. The consultancy will serve to (i) design a roadmap that would identify, classify and prioritize activities necessary for the envisioned justice administration modernization, and (ii) prepare preliminary improvement plans to be implemented as part of future loan programs. These objectives should be achieved in a participatory manner involving management and staff of all relevant agencies, as well as other stakeholders.

The Inter-American Development Bank now invites eligible consultants to indicate their interest in providing these services. Interested consultants must provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services (brochures, description of similar assignments, experience in similar conditions, availability of appropriate skills among staff, etc.). Consultants may associate to enhance their qualifications.

Consultants will be selected as per Selection Based on Consultants' Qualification (SBCQ) method in accordance with IDB *[Policies for the Selection and Contracting of Consultants financed by the Inter-American Development Bank – January 2005.](#)*
