The Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) has received financing from the Sustainable Energy and Climate Change Initiative Investment Funds, and it intends to apply the proceeds to payments under the project Developing LULUCF Investment Opportunities for the LAC Region. The project aims to provide the public institutions responsible for forest protection and management in the IDB member countries with technical expertise and financial means to fully participate in LULUCF (Land Use, Land Use Change and Forestry) related initiatives.

For this service, entities with experience in this area will be hired for the execution of the following tasks: (i) identification of feasible projects and investments in LULUCF activities in the public sector, (ii) the development of LULUCF investment opportunities at the national and regional levels, (iii) providing advisory service on how countries may engage with emerging LULUCF funding mechanisms such as the FIP (Forest Investment Program).

The contract will be for 24 months and services will be rendered electronically via the web platform itself.

The IDB now invites eligible consultants to express their interest in providing the services. Interested consultants must submit information establishing that they are qualified to perform the services (brochures, description of similar assignments, experience in similar conditions, availability of appropriate skills among staff, etc.). Consultants may associate to enhance their qualifications.

Selection of consultants will be in accordance with the procedures set out in the IDB's <I>Policies for the Selection and Contracting of Consultants financed by the Inter-American Development Bank</I> (current edition) and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the policies.
