The Government of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago has received a loan in various currencies from the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) toward the cost of the Health Sector Reform Program; it is intended that part of the proceeds of this loan be applied to eligible payments under the contracts for supply and installation of equipment and the completion of the necessary services infrastructure refurbishment/upgrade for which this bid is issued.

The National Insurance Property Development Company Limited (NIPDEC) hereby invites companies from IDB's member countries to submit sealed bids for the work package (supply and installation of equipment and refurbishment of services infrastructure systems) Eric Williams Medical Sciences Complex - Upgrade Works - Phase I:

Bidding documents may be inspected at the address stated below.

A set of bidding documents may be obtained upon payment of a non-refundable fee of US\$ 50.00 (TT\$ 300) from NIPDEC at the address below.

It may not be necessary to make the request in person to receive a complete set of bidding documents, since these can be sent by mail upon receipt of an appropriate form of payment.

Contractors/suppliers must submit their respective statements of interest and price bids in sealed envelopes, with proof of their legal, technical and financial capacity. The intention is to award a contract to the bidder who, after meeting all the mandatory requirements and reaching the minimum number of qualifying points for each evaluation category as set out in the tender documents, has quoted the lowest comparative price.

Sealed bids must be deposited in the specific marked tender box in the office mentioned below by 1400 hours (Trinidad and Tobago time), on Thursday, 30 September 2004.

It will not be necessary to submit bids in person, since they may be sent by mail. However, the employer is not responsible for documents not received by the time and date specified for reception of bids, in which case they will be rejected and returned unopened.

Bids will be opened at a public ceremony in the presence of the representatives of firms who choose to attend, at 1430 hours, on Thursday, 30 September 2004 at the address below.

Interested parties are asked to submit their bids responsive to the bidding documents and in the form, number of copies and properly addressed as detailed in the documents.
