**PROCUREMENT OF LANDFILL EQUIPMENT FOR NEW PROVIDENCE SANITARY LANDFILL**

The Government of the Commonwealth of the Bahamas has received a loan from the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) toward the cost of the Bahamas Solid Waste Management Program, and it intends to apply part of the loan proceeds to the purchase of heavy-duty equipment for the New Providence Sanitary Landfill.

The Project Executing Unit, under the auspices of the Department of Environmental Health Services and the Ministry of Health, now invites firms, joint ventures or consortia from IDB's member countries to participate in this bidding process by presenting sealed bids for the supply of the equipment below to be used on a landfill. The procurement procedures for contracting for the supply of goods financed by this program will be subject to the provisions of this loan contract.

The equipment to be supplied is listed below (with the minimum basic specifications described). Bidders may bid on the package.

- Landfill compactor (1) - 826G or equivalent, with a gross power no less than 340 HP (254 kW) and flywheel power no less than 315 HP (235 kW), an operating weight no less than 73,537 pounds (33,350 Kg) and command control steering

Interested parties may obtain further information, including eligibility to participate, and may obtain a copy of the bidding document from the office at the address below.

Interested bidders may purchase a complete set of bidding documents by submitting a written application to the Department of Environmental Health Services and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of US\$ 50. The methods of payment will be certified check or cash.

Tenders must be submitted in sealed envelope(s), marked "Tenders for the Procurement of Landfill Equipment", and delivered to the second address below no later than 1630 hours on 26 May 2003. The purchaser is not responsible for bids not received thereof on or before the time and date specified for their reception. Late bids will be rejected and returned unopened.

All tenders must be submitted in triplicate. Tenders will be opened at 1000 hours on 27 May 2003 at the office of the Tender's Board, Ministry of Finance and Planning.

The Government reserves the right to reject any or all tenders.
