DESCRIPTION

The Program includes the construction of sanitation and urban infrastructure for the city of Ciudad de la Costa in the Montevideo Metropolitan Area. The works to be constructed include: (i) A wastewater removal and treatment system; (ii) A storm water drainage system; and (iii) Pavement for the roads within the neighborhoods. The project will also include component for the institutional strengthening of the executing agencies, as necessary to ensure efficient implementation of the operation. In parallel with this operation, the IDB is providing non-reimbursable financing, through a Technical Cooperation using TC Funds (UR-T1028), for the design and creation of a public company to operate and maintain the stormwater drainage system.

BANKS COUNTRY STRATEGY

The Bank's Country Strategy for Uruguay is to contribute to sustainable development to halt the negative effects on social indicators of the recession and the financial crisis of 2001. The intention is to create the conditions for a sustainable improvement in the population's standard of living. The Bank's technical cooperation and credit operations will be focused on three strategic areas: (i) Improving public management and fiscal sustainability, (ii) Improving the countries capacity to compete in international markets, and (iii) As a pillar of sustainable development, reducing poverty and social exclusion. The present operation, in conjunction with the parallel Technical Cooperation (UR-T1028) which will form a public company to finance and manage the operation and maintenance of the storm water drainage system, is compatible with the first of the three strategic areas.

OBJECTIVES

The objective of the operation will be to provide improved sanitary and urban conditions for the people of Ciudad de la Costa.

EXPECTED RESULTS

The main outcome of the operation will be an improvement in the quality of life and productivity of the population of Ciudad de la Costa through improved storm water drainage during the wet season. A wider population will benefit from the wastewater removal and treatment system that will cover additional towns within the Municipality of Canelones. A secondary result will be the improved management of public services through the public company to be created, which will finance and manage operation and maintenance of the stormwater drainage.
