Invitation for Bids No. WSG - BRB 12006; Invitation for Prequalification

The Government of Guyana has received financing from the Inter-American Development Bank toward the cost of the Berbice River Crossing Access Roads under the Main Road Rehabilitation Programme Phase II. It is intended that part of the proceeds of this financing be applied to eligible payments under the contract for the construction of the Berbice River Crossing Access Roads.

The Government of Guyana, acting by and through the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Public Works and Communications, invites sealed bids from interested parties, with proof of their legal, technical and financial capacity for the provision of consulting services for the rehabilitation of 5 km of roads works.

Interested bidders may obtain further information, including eligibility to participate, and may purchase a set of prequalification documents by written communication or by applying in person to the office of the Works Services Group, Ministry of Public Works and Communications (first address below), between 0800 and 1600 hours, except on public holidays, and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of US\$ 40 or 8,000 Guyana dollars. Parties who request that the prequalification documents be sent to them will be required to pay in advance for this service.

Bids must be placed in an envelope, marked on the outside at the top right hand corner "Prequalification for Consulting Services – Berbice River Bridge Access Roads" and on the left hand corner the name and address of the bidder, in an envelope sealed and addressed to the Chairman, National Board for Procurement and Tender Administration, Ministry of Finance (second address below).

Bids must be placed in the tender box of the National Board for Procurement and Tender Administration at the same address at or before 0900 hours on Tuesday, 11 April 2006. It will not be necessary to submit bids in person since they may be sent by mail. However the employer is not responsible for bids not received thereof at or before the time and date specified for reception of bids. Late bids will be rejected and returned unopened.

Bids will be opened immediately thereafter in a public ceremony, in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend, in the Conference Room of the National Board for Procurement and Tender Administration, Ministry of Finance.
