Invitation for Bids No.WSG – BR-1 2006

The Government of Guyana has received financing from the Inter-American Development Bank toward the cost of the Berbice River Bridge Approach Roads under the Main Road Rehabilitation Programme Phase II. It is intended that part of the proceeds of this financing be applied to eligible payments under the contract for the construction of the Berbice River Bridge Approach Roads.

The Government of Guyana, acting by and through the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Public Works and Communications, invites sealed bids from interested parties, with proof of their legal, technical and financial capacity, for the provision of contracting services for the construction of approximately 5 km of roads works.

Interested bidders may obtain further information, including eligibility to participate, and may purchase a set of the bidding documents on written communication or application in person to the office of the Works Services group, Ministry of Public Works and Communications, at the first address below, between 0800 and 1600 hours, except on public holidays, and upon payment of a non-refundable sum of US\$ 50 or 10,000 Guyana dollars. Parties who request that the bidding documents be sent to them will be required to pay in advance for this service.

Bids must be placed in an envelope, marked on the outside at the top right hand corner “Construction – Berbice River Bridge Approach Roads”, with the name and address of the bidder on the left hand corner, addressed to the Chairman, National Board for Procurement and Tender Administration, Ministry of Finance (second address below).

Bids must be placed in the tender box of the National Board for Procurement and Tender Administration at the same address at or before 0900 hours on Tuesday, 9 January 2007. It will not be necessary to submit bids in person since they may be sent by mail. However, the employer is not responsible for bids not received thereof at or before the time and date specified for reception. Late bids will be rejected and returned unopened.

Bids will be opened at a public ceremony in the presence of the bidders’ representatives who choose to attend at 0900 hours on Tuesday, 9 January 2007 in the Board Room of the National Board for Procurement and Tender Administration, Ministry of Finance.
