**Invitation for Prequalification**

The Government of Trinidad and Tobago is currently implementing the Agriculture Sector Reform Programme – Technical Assistance Programme (ASRP-TAP), with funding support from the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB). The ASRP-TAP involves assistance to a range of policy and institutional reforms to strengthen the performance of the agricultural sector and the wider economy.

One of the specific areas of reform in the overall ASRP-TAP is the development of agribusiness through the provision of technical assistance by local and international consultants.

The Ministry of Agriculture, Land and Marine Resources wishes to hire consultants to work with the Sugar Manufacturing Company Ltd., a wholly-owned State Enterprise as follows:

- \*One mechanical engineer for Usine Saint Madeline Factory: Cane yard, mills, boilers and power house
- \*One mechanical engineer for Usine Saint Madeline Factory: Process house and refinery
- \*One sugar factory process engineer for Usine Saint Madeline factory: Refinery process house

Candidates must clearly state on the outside of the envelope the consultancy in which they are interested.

Prospective candidates must be citizens or permanent residents of IDB's member countries.

Résumés must be deposited in the brown tenders box located in the lobby of the Central Tenders Board's Office no later than 1300 hours (local time) on Thursday, 2 September 2004. They will be opened shortly thereafter at the Board's Office in the presence of the individuals who choose to attend. Late submissions will not be considered.

The Central Tenders Board reserves the right to cancel the present bidding process in its entirety or even partially without defraying the cost incurred by any consulting firm submitting documentation.
