Introduction

This report contains the participation and consultation process for the “Water Network Expansion Project to Harmonyville, Cayo District” and “Water Network Expansion Project to South San Pedro & Marina Drive, Ambergris Caye, Belize District” projects, hereinafter “the Projects”.

To carry out this process, the [Meaningful Stakeholder Consultation Guide \(IDB, 2017\)](#) was taken as a reference. Also, the team’s work experience in the area was taken into account.

Objective

The purpose of the consultation is to inform stakeholders about the socio-environmental impacts (negative and positive), mitigation measures and the mechanism for handling complaints and grievances of the Program. Likewise, the process includes a space for stakeholders to express their opinions, concerns and share opportunities for improvement in the socio-environmental issues of the Program.

The consultation also seeks to add value to the Program by:

- Becoming aware of **the views and perceptions** of people (in gender equality and opportunities of vulnerable groups) who may be affected or have an interest in a development project, and provides a means for those views to be taken into account as inputs to an improved Program design and implementation, which avoids or reduces adverse impacts and increases benefits.
- It provides an important source of **validation and verification** of data obtained elsewhere, and improves the quality of environmental and social impact assessments.
- Helps people understand their **rights and responsibilities** in relation to the Program.
- Promotes greater transparency and stakeholder participation by increasing **trust, project acceptance and local ownership**, which are key to project sustainability and development outcomes.
- It is carried out on an ongoing basis as risks and impacts emerge; it considers and **addresses feedback**.
- It is an **IDB requirement** in accordance with environmental and social policies, in projects that have the potential to cause harm to people or the environment.
- It is essential for the **credibility and legitimacy** of executing agencies and international financial institutions such as the IDB.
- It is free from external manipulation, interference, coercion, discrimination, retaliation and intimidation.

Preparation of the Public Consultation Process

Public Consultation Process organization and planning

The project consultation process was face-to-face with involved residents and stakeholders. The objective of the process is to provide more details about the project while providing a space for

residents to raise concerns or questions about the project. General details of both events are described below:

- Public consultation for Water Network Expansion to San Pedro South and Marina Drive, Ambergris Caye, Belize District: Friday, December 16, 2022, 6 pm on the main street at the entrance of the Eiley Dub-division.
- Public consultation for Water Network Expansion to Harmonyville, Cayo District: Thursday, December 15, 2022, 6:00 pm at Iglesia de Dios de la Profecía in Harmonyville.

Stakeholder analysis

Starting from the preparation of the environmental and social documents, potential adverse impacts were identified, as well as risks, relevant opportunities and the way in which they may affect different groups. Based on these impacts, a specific analysis was carried out to identify stakeholders in order to invite them to participate in the participatory process throughout the Program cycle and especially in the foundational milestone of this process, which is the public consultation.

In this way, key stakeholders such as community leaders and members were invited for the consultation and participation instance in order to ensure that each of the identified groups are represented and have the opportunity to express their opinions.



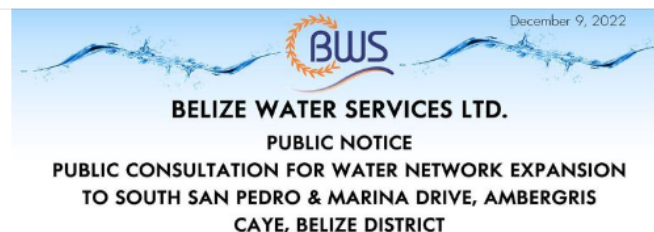

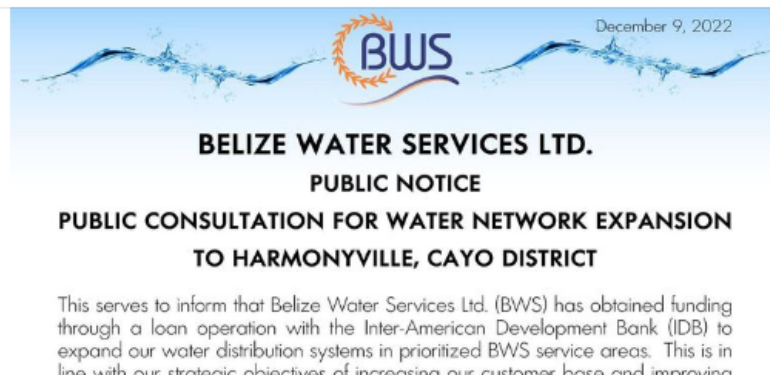



Figure 7 - Facebook Notice to Harmonyville

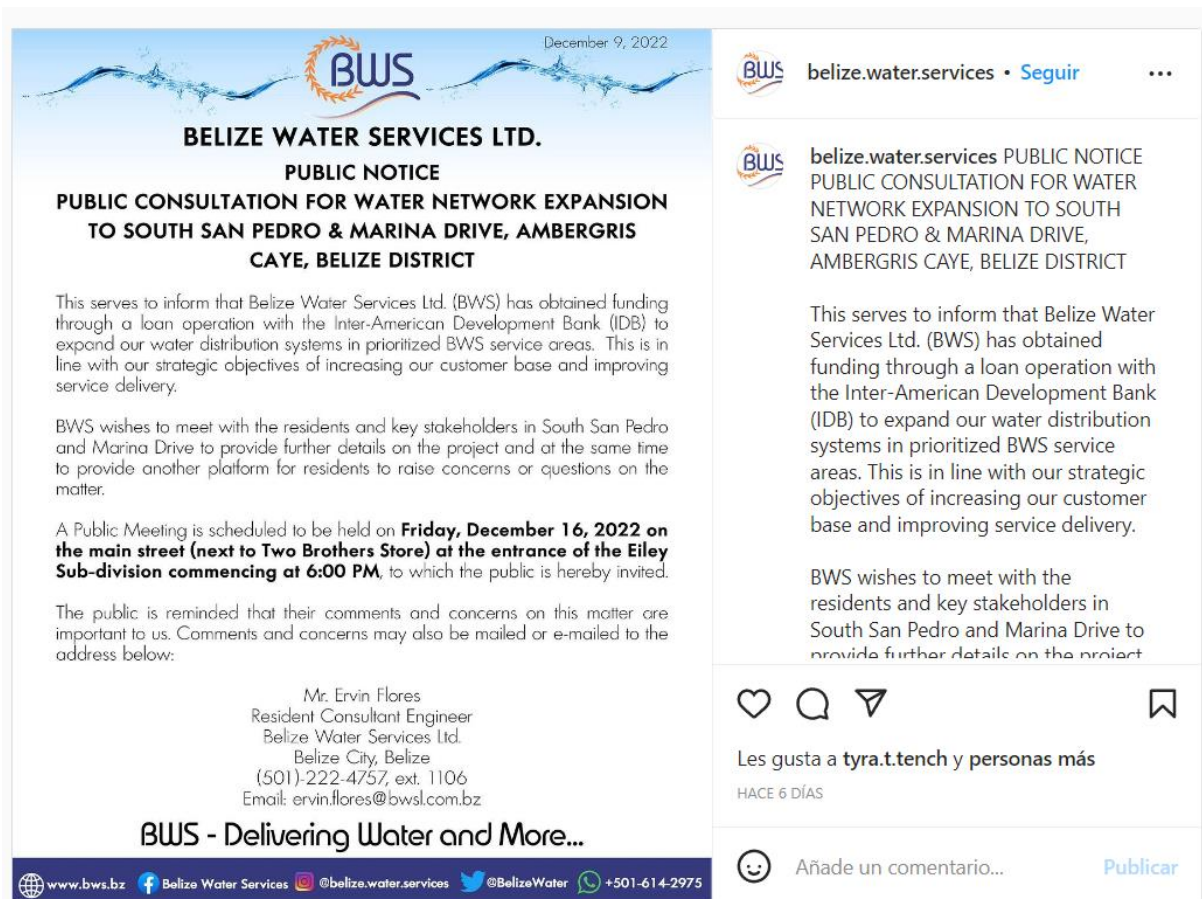


Figure 10 - Instagram Notice to South San Pedro & Marina Drive

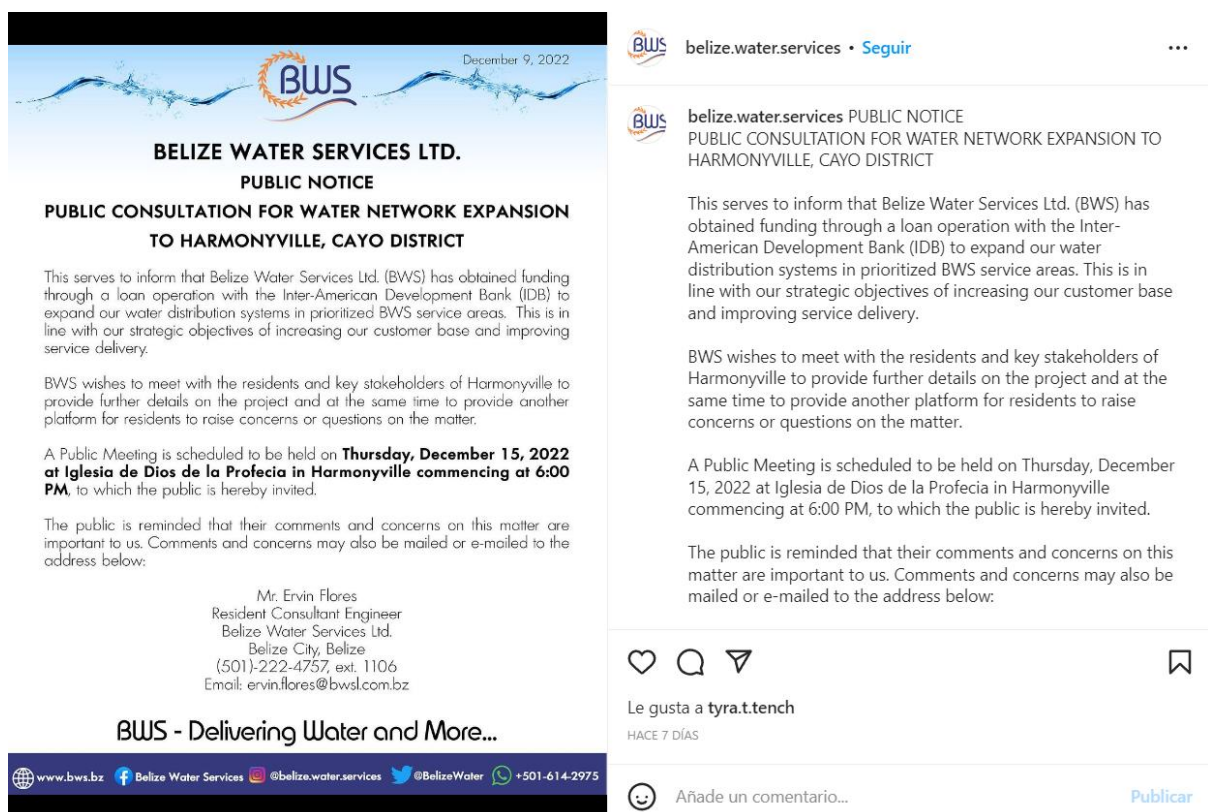


Figure 11 - Instagram Notice to Harmonyville

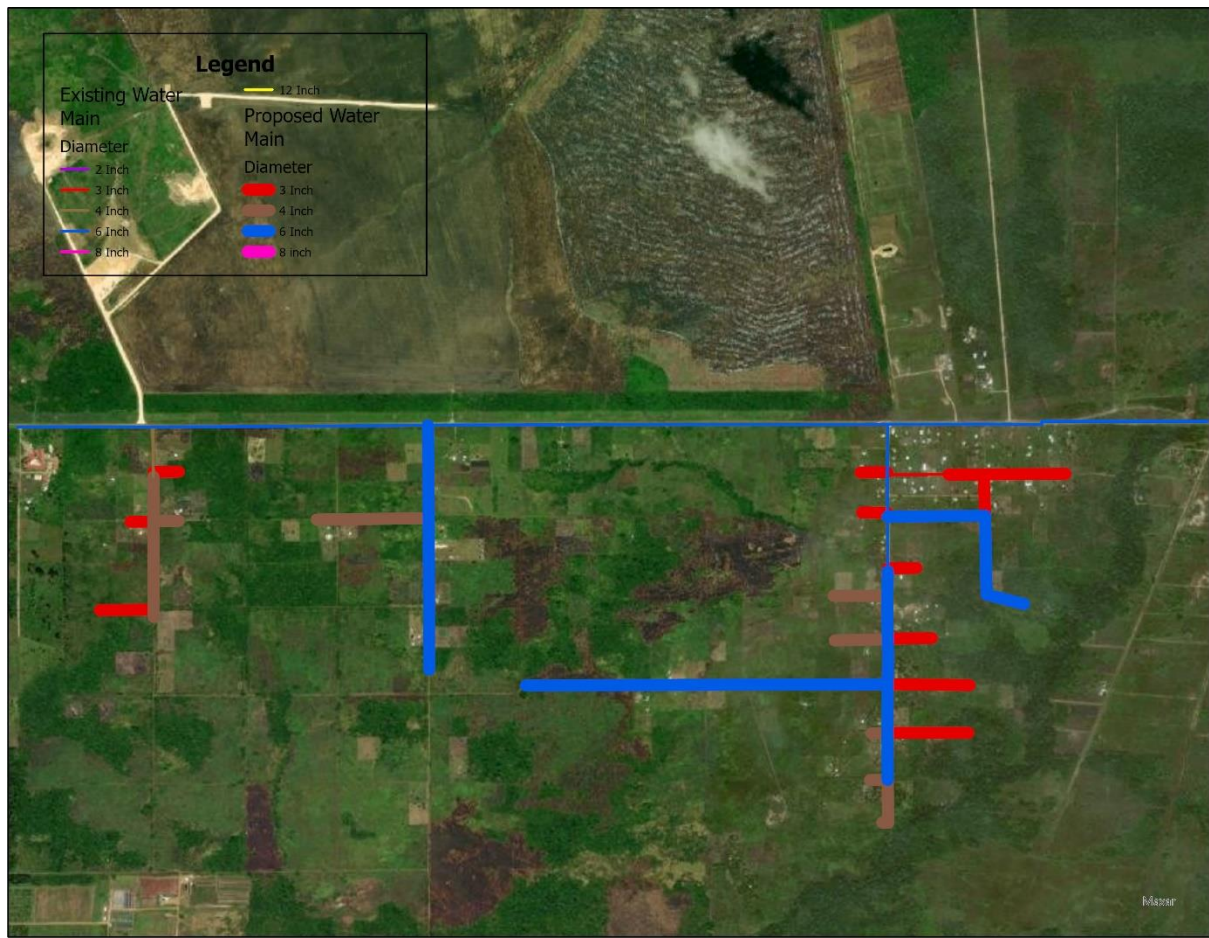


Figure 18 – Slide of Existing and proposed water Main, Harmonyville Water Network Expansion.

Finally, the section for questions to the public is opened. Some of the questions raised at the meeting are listed below:

A participant inquired about the requirements to connect to the service. BWS informed that the required documents are the land document and identification.

It was also asked if residents need to have their property documents finalized in order to apply for the water service. BWS reported that it is not necessary, it is sufficient to have a receipt certifying that it is in process.

Another participant inquired if BWS can install pipelines and service connections for the entire planned community, including areas where there are no properties at this time. BWS advised that it only considers the immediate existing residents. It does not expand to vacant lots unless there is proof of intent to build (e.g., approved CBA drawings, signed construction contract).

Finally, they inquired if a connection can be made through a neighbor's property in the case where there is no main on the road. BWS replied that connections can only be made directly from a water main.

Once the questions were finished, participants were provided with the contact information of Mr. Ervin Flores for any related inquiries.

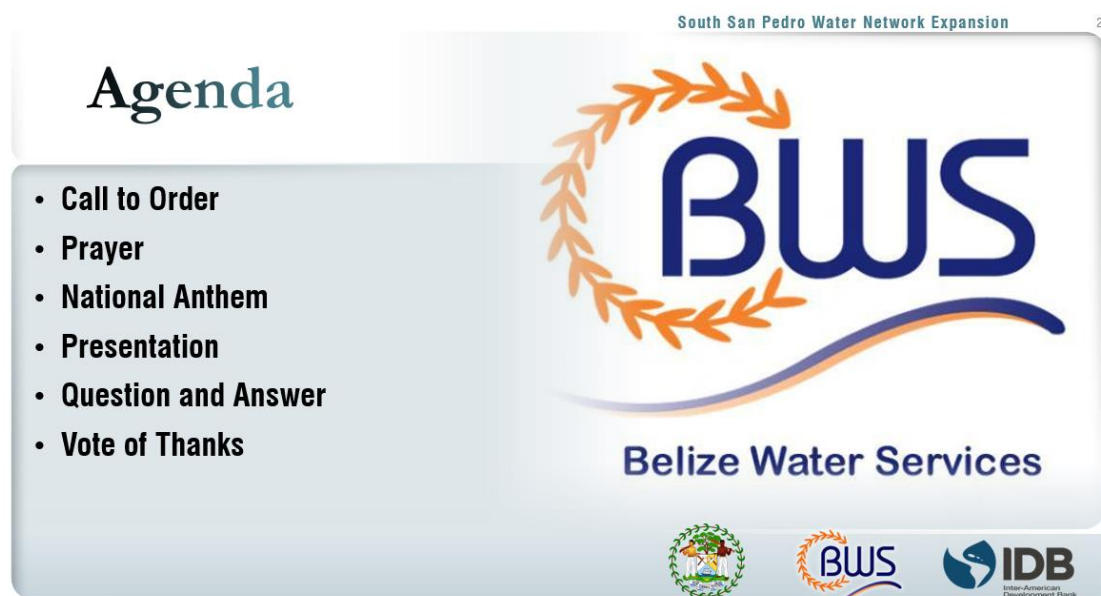


Figure 23 – Slide of Public consultation Agenda

Finally, the section for questions to the public is opened. Some of the questions raised at the meeting are listed below:

A participant asks if all loan funds are going to projects in San Pedro. The response from BWS was that no, they are earmarked for another location as well.

Another participant asks: What other projects has BWS done in San Pedro recently? BWS informs that other projects recently carried out are for example, the acquisition of CWBL, the new RO plant, the reservoir.

A third participant asks, what are the requirements to connect? to which BWS informs that land document and identification are required.

Most of the questions asked in San Pedro were from residents who wanted confirmation that their property would be included in the expansion project. After the meeting, the project engineers confirmed them one by one.

Following the Questions, participants were provided with the contact information of Mr. Ervin Flores for any related inquiries.

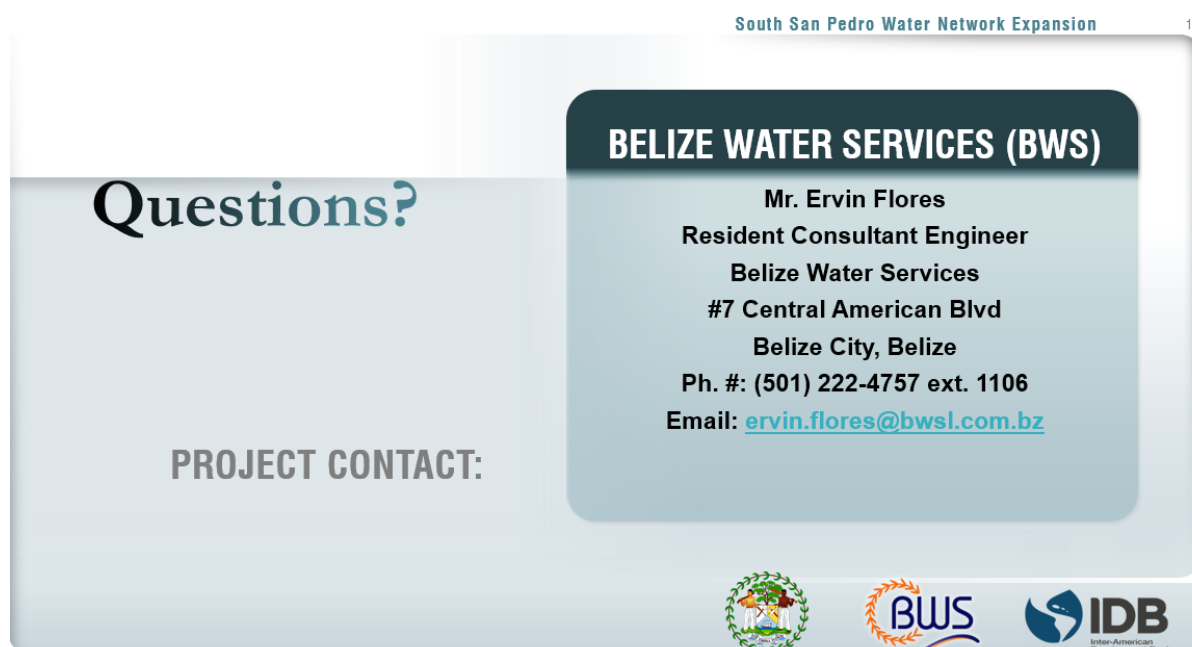


Figure 30 - Slide of project contact

Public Consultation Process Conclusions

This section details the main conclusions and recommendations received by the Program from the stakeholders invited to participate in the public consultation for both projects:

- The projects were positively valued by all parties present, highlighting their importance and necessity for the environmental and social health of the community.
- No negative impacts or novel risks were identified, in relation to those presented in the Environmental and Social Impact Assessment prepared for the Projects. To address the moderate negative risks, the Projects have environmental and social management plans that are adequate and proportional to the risks identified.

- No conflicting interests were expressed with the objectives set out in the Program.
- There was general support for the initiative and the proposal was received with great enthusiasm.
- The public consultation achieved a high level of participation, showing different points of view, guaranteeing the voice of multiple people, and achieving an orderly and planned process. The necessary prior information was provided in a transparent, equitable and non-discriminatory manner, making it a meaningful consultation, proportional to the risk and complexity of the project.

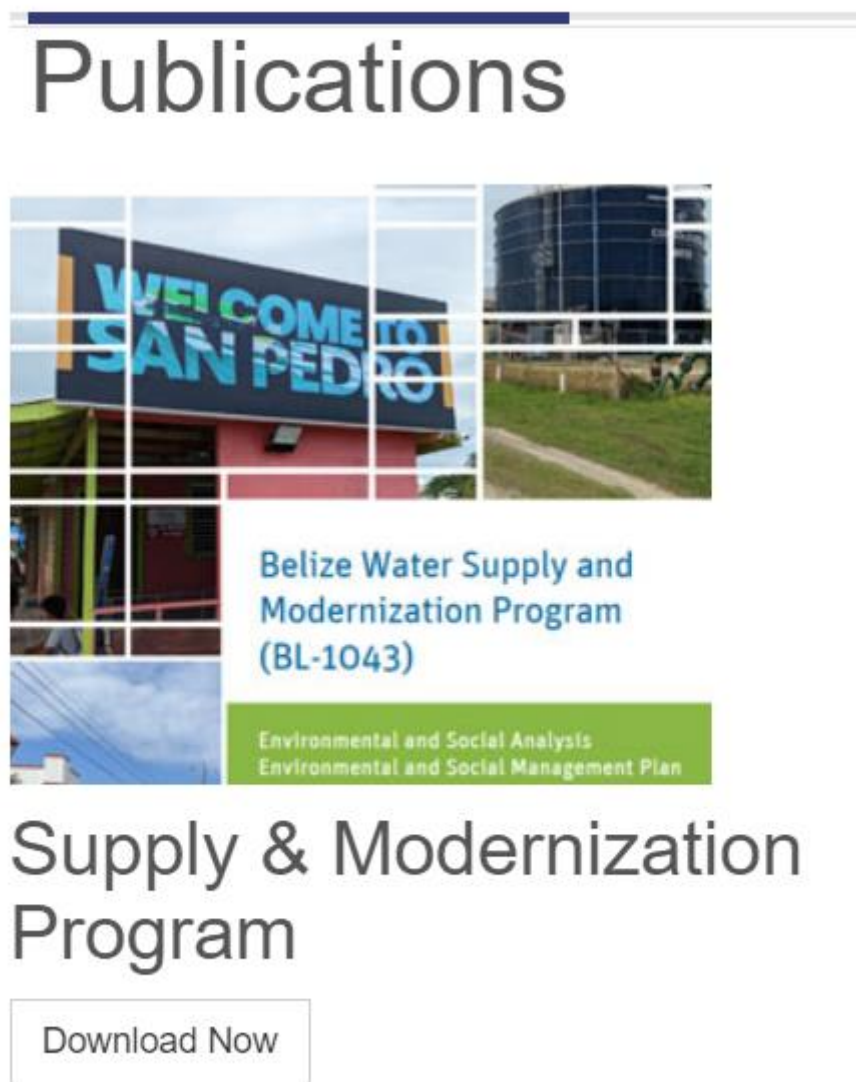


Figure 31 - Publications on the BWS official website (<https://www.bws.bz/>)
