SUPPLY OF PIPES AND FITTINGS

The Ministry of Water and Housing has received a loan from the Inter-American Development Bank toward the cost of the GOJ/ IDB Rural Water Programme, and it intends to apply part of the loan proceeds to payments under the contract for supply of pipes and fittings for the White Horses/ Botany Bay/ Pamphret Water Supply Project in Saint Thomas, Jamaica.

The approximate total quantity of pipes is as follows:

- 7,000 m of 250 mm diameter ductile iron pipes
- 7,400 m of 200 mm PVC pipes along with fittings, valves and appurtenances

The Ministry of Water and Housing now invites sealed bids from the IDB's member countries for the supply of these pipes and fittings.

The bidding documents may be obtained from the address below upon payment of a non-refundable fee of J\$ 5,000 (or US\$ 100) in cash or cashier's/manager's check in favor of the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Water and Housing.

A bid security of J\$ 250,000 (US\$ 5,000) in the form of a bank guarantee or certified check shall be submitted along with the bid.

The origin of goods must be member countries of the IDB. Only suppliers who are nationals of IDB's member countries are eligible to bid.

Sealed bids, in English, inclusive of all relevant enclosures, in a plain envelope marked "Tender for the Supply of Pipes and Fittings, White Horses/Botany Bay/ Pamphret Water Supply Project", must be delivered to the address below by 1000 hours on 25 February 2003. Bids shall be opened at 1030 hours on the same day, in the presence of the bidders or their representatives who choose to attend, at the same address.
