Prequalification Notice

The Government of Jamaica has received full financing from the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) for the Transportation Infrastructure Rehabilitation Programme.

The National Works Agency (NWA), an implementing agency of the Ministry of Transport and Works (MTW) of the GoJ, invites eligible contractors to submit documents to prequalify for the Road Rehabilitation and Improvement Works on the Negril to Sheffield Road section in Westmoreland under the above-mentioned program.

The proposed works on the 6-km road section Negril to Sheffield includes—but is not limited to—bushing, cleaning drains drainage improvements (box and cylindrical culverts), laying kerbs, sidewalks, road surface repairs, rehabilitation works, preparatory, regulatory and resurfacing works with Asphaltic Concrete Overlay, road markings and signage.

Eligibility:

- All applicants and subsidiaries must be nationals from member countries of the IDB.
- Local contractors must be registered with the National Contracts Commission (NCC) in the “General Road Works” Grade 1 Category, and must have a valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC) at the time of tendering.
- Foreign contractors (if successful) will be required to obtain the necessary NCC registration and a TCC before the award of contract.

Prequalification documents (in English) will be available as of Wednesday, 15 December 2010, from the Programme Manager, NWA, at the address below. A non-refundable payment of J\$ 3,000 in cash or Manager’s check payable to the Chief Executive Officer - National Works Agency is required for each set of prequalification documents.

Completed prequalification questionnaires, with the supporting documents, must be placed in an envelope clearly marked "Prequalification Questionnaire" and be placed in the tender box marked “IDB Loan 2026/OC-JA Transportation Infrastructure Rehabilitation Programme - Statement of Capability - Negril to Sheffield Rehabilitation and Improvement Works”, located in the main lobby of the NWA, no later than 11:00 hours on Wednesday, 12 January 2011.

Local applicants are to submit the completed questionnaires along with NCC, TCC and other supporting prequalification documentation as requested.

Prequalification documents will be publicly opened at 11:30 hours on Wednesday, 12 January 2011, in the Main Conference Room, 2nd floor, NWA. Subsequently the evaluation exercise will be carried out by an evaluation team of the NWA/MTW. The list of successful applicants can be made available to other applicants on request.
