Invitation To Tender

The Government of Jamaica (GoJ) has received full financing from the Inter-America Development Bank (IDB) for the Transportation Infrastructure Rehabilitation Programme. The works will be executed by the National Works Agency (NWA), an executive agency of the Government of Jamaica.

The Ministry of Transport and Works / NWA invites eligible contractors to submit tenders for the Negril to Sheffield Drainage Improvement Work Project - Phase II, in the vicinity of the Negril Hill golf course in Westmoreland.

The proposed works will consist mainly of drainage improvement inclusive of the construction of a 1.5 m x 3 m box culvert, 185 m of HDPE 1200 mm dia. pipe culvert, 800 m² of retaining wall; excavation and fill for the vertical alignment of 250 m of roadway, road reinstatement and repairs with asphaltic concrete overlay and improvement to road safety.

Eligibility:

--All contractors must be nationals from member countries of the IDB.

--Local contractors must be registered with the National Contracts Commission (NCC) in Grade 1 of “Civil Engineering” Category, and must have a valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC) at the time of tender.

--Foreign contractors (if successful) will be required to obtain the necessary NCC registration and TCC before the award of contract.

All queries concerning the tender documents must be made in writing and addressed to Mr. Desrick Litchmore, Programme Manager, Transportation Infrastructure Rehabilitation Programme – IDB Loan 2026, National Works Agency, at the address below.

Tender Documents (in English) will be available as of Tuesday, 22 February 2011, from the Programme Manager, Transportation Infrastructure Rehabilitation Programme – NWA. A non-refundable payment of J\$ 3,000 or US dollars equivalent in cash or Manager’s check made payable to the Chief Executive Officer, NWA, is required for each set of tender documents.

Completed tender documents are to be placed in an envelope marked “Tender Documents for the Transportation Infrastructure Rehabilitation Programme - IDB Loan 2026 – Negril to Sheffield Drainage Improvement Work - Phase II”.

Contractors with tender documents not accompanied by a valid TCC and NCC Certificate Grade 1 “Civil Engineering Works” Category will be rejected. Documents are to be placed in the box marked “Tender Documents for the Transportation Infrastructure Rehabilitation Programme - IDB Loan 2026 – Negril to Sheffield Drainage Improvement Work - Phase II”, located in the lobby of the National Works Agency, at the address below, no later than 11:00 hours on Wednesday, 23 March 2011. Tender documents will be opened publicly at 11:15 hours in the Main Conference Room, NWA.
