The Project has three major components:

2. Development of Commercial ADR
3. Registry/Court Administration-Diagnostic, Design and Implementation of MIS Procedures

The Office of the Chief Justice, Supreme Court, Guyana, invites individual consultants in the specialized components to submit résumés indicating academic background, area of expertise and proven track record of providing the specialized skills required for the particular component.
