The Government of the Commonwealth of The Bahamas has received Supplementary Financing from the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) toward the financing of the New Providence Transport Program (NPTP) in The Bahamas. It is intended that part of the proceeds of this financing be applied for the procurement of consulting services for the program Mid-Term Evaluation.

The purpose of the project is to reduce transport costs for road users by providing a more rational and efficient transport system for New Providence. The specific objectives of the funding are to contribute to the improvement of the existing road network, the modernization and strengthening of the institutional framework for the provision of public transport services and the alleviation of the negative environmental impacts associated with the existing traffic congestion levels.

The Ministry of Public Works and Transport now invites individual consultants, who are suitably qualified to submit their EOI to undertake evaluation of the results of the NPTP, based on the original design, objectives, targets and indicators while taking into consideration the various opportunities, issues and challenges experienced over the elapsed period of implementation and confronting the project for the future. The total duration of the consultancy assignment is expected to take approximately 20 non-consecutive days in total. This is to be provided by an individual Consultant during a one-month period (projected for June of 2011). The assignment will be executed in Nassau, New Providence, Bahamas.

EOI must include signed curriculum vitae emphasizing details of work performed of a relevant nature.

*Summary of the qualifications:

--Professional with 15 years of post-graduate experience in the project planning, design, implementation and results monitoring and evaluation for projects/programs financed by international development organizations

--Five years minimum professional experience in the development, analysis and evaluation of international development projects is desirable

--The consultant should preferably have a full command of the English language, previous experience in the Caribbean, prior demonstrated experience in the planning, Administration/management and evaluation of projects in the transport sector.

*A consultant will be selected in accordance with the procedures set out in the IDB's <I>Policies for the Selection and Contracting of Consultants financed by the Inter-American Development Bank</I> (GN-2350-7) dated July 2006.

Three Copies of EOI must be enclosed in a sealed envelope and addressed to “The Chairperson, Tenders Board, Ministry of Finance”. The EOI should be sent to the address below no later than 6 June 2011.
