WHEREAS, the Inter-American Development Bank (hereinafter referred to as the “IDB”) is a public international organization, the purpose of which is to contribute to the acceleration of the process of economic and social development of its regional developing member countries in Latin America and the Caribbean, individually and collectively; and

WHEREAS, the Stockholm International Water Institute (hereinafter referred to as “SIWI”) is a Stockholm-based policy institute that generates knowledge and informs decision-making towards water wise policy.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties have agreed to enter into this Letter of Intent (“LoI”).

The objective of this LoI is to facilitate collaboration between the parties and to express the intention of SIWI and the IDB to cooperate during the World Water Week in Stockholm for the 2015-2017 period and more specifically in regards to the Latin America and the Caribbean Focus Day.

Understanding that the Regional Focus Days are an important component of the World Water Week in Stockholm, where regional actors organize and host in cooperation with SIWI, events which cover topics of importance to the regions and have as its objective to foster the dialogue with actors that operate within the different regions.

To this end, this LoI formalizes the role of the IDB as the coordinator of the Latin America and the Caribbean Focus Day for the period 2015-2017 and establishes the partnership under which the cooperation between the parties related to the Latin America and the Caribbean Focus Day during the World Water Week will take place.

In its role, the IDB will coordinate with SIWI, other regional organizations and potential partners the Latin America and the Caribbean Focus Day. In addition, the IDB will be SIWI’s point on contact for the events that fall under the umbrella of the Regional Day.

The IDB’s fulfillment of the intentions detailed herein and any future commitment on behalf of the IDB will be subject to the IDB’s compliance with its policies and procedures for the commitment of resources, including all necessary internal approvals and the fulfillment of all conditions for implementation and written agreements between the parties.


