The Petroleum Corporation of Jamaica (PCJ) acting on behalf of the Government of Jamaica has received joint financing in the amount of US\$30,000,000.00 from the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) and Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA), and it intends to apply part of the proceeds to payments for goods, works, related services and consulting services to be procured under the project Energy Management and Efficiency Programme. Bidding will be governed by the Inter-American Development Bank's eligibility rules and procedures.

The main objectives of this programme is to promote energy efficiency in government facilities and fuel conservation in road transportation by contributing to the avoidance of fuel imports. The specific objectives and expected results of this programme are: (i) reduced electricity consumption within health, education and public agency government facilities, which translates into lower CO₂ emissions; (ii) reduced travel times and avoided fuel consumption through improved traffic control management, which translates to lower CO₂ emissions; and (iii) increased capacity within the Ministry of Science, Energy and Technology (MSET) of Jamaica to enable it to update the country's Integrated Resource Plan (IRP) for Jamaica.

The following is a general description of the procurement planned for the proposed programme.

Works Procurement:

- Deep Retrofitting of twenty-three (23) Government Facilities (hospitals, schools, and public agency buildings)
- Installation of an Urban Traffic Management System in Kingston Metropolitan Area

Procurement of Consulting Services (Firms + Individuals):

- Consultancy service for the supervision of RE & EE Deep Retrofitting of government facilities
- Consultancy service for Lighting Audit and Review
- Technical Study to Support the Jamaica's Integrated Resource Plan
- Diagnostic Study for IT Platform within the Ministry of Science, Energy and technology of Jamaica.

Procurement of Goods:

- Lighting Retrofits - 50 Government Facilities (schools, public agency buildings)
- Supply of a Lift Truck
- Supply and installation of IT Software in the Ministry of Science, Energy & Technology of Jamaica

Procurement processes of contracts financed by the Inter-American Development Bank will be conducted in accordance with the [*Policies for Procurement of Goods and Works financed by the Inter-American Development Bank*](#) (current edition) and the Government of Jamaica (GoJ) Public Sector Procurement Procedures, and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the policies. Consulting services will be selected and contracted in accordance with the [*Policies for the Selection and Contracting of Consultants financed by the Inter-American Development Bank*](#) (current edition).

Specific procurement notices for contracts to be bid under the Inter-American Development Bank's international competitive bidding (ICB) procedures, will be published as they become available. For consulting services expected to cost an amount equivalent to US \$200,000 or more, a request for expressions of interest contracts will be advertised in *UN Development Business*ⁱ and [*Inter-American Development Bank's*](#) Web Site, www.egovja.com, The Gleaner Newspaper and www.pcj.com
