STRENGTHENING OF AIRPORT SECURITY
Agreement No. ATN/MT 8045-TT

The Government of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago has signed a non-reimbursable Technical Cooperation Agreement with the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) with a view to upgrading and enhancing the aviation security systems and processes.

The Central Tenders Board now invites sealed bids from eligible individuals from IDB's member countries for the provision of consultancy services in the following areas:

- (a) Development and delivery of a training program in the identification and detection of bombs and other incendiary devices
- (b) Development and delivery of a training program in incident and hostage negotiations
- (c) Review and update of the airport emergency and contingency plans

Interested individuals may obtain further information from Mr. Neil Ferdinand, Project Coordinator, or according to projects (a), (b) and (c) below.

Bidding documents may be obtained during normal working hours from the Central Tenders Board's Office, at address (2) below.

Bidders are required to submit their proposals (the original and four copies) using two envelopes clearly marked:

- Envelope 1: (a) "Technical Proposal - Provision of Consultancy Services for the Development and Delivery of a Training Programme in the Identification and Detection of Bombs and other Incendiary Devices; or (b) "Technical Proposal - Provision of Consultancy Services for the Development and Delivery of a Training Programme in Incident and Hostage Negotiations"; or (c) "Technical Proposal - Provision of Consultancy Services for the Review and Update of the Airport Emergency and Contingency Plans"
- Envelope 2: (a) "Financial Proposal - Provision of Consultancy Services for Development and Delivery of a Training Programme in the Identification and Detection of Bombs and other Incendiary Devices"; or (b) "Financial Proposal - Provision of Consultancy Services for the Development and Delivery of a Training Programme in Incident and Hostage Negotiations"; or (c) "Financial Proposal - Provision of Consultancy Services for the Review and Update of the Airport Emergency and Contingency Plans"

Envelopes must be addressed to the Chairman, Central Tenders Board, at address (2) below, and be deposited in the brown tenders box located in the lobby of the Board's Office no later than 1300 hours on Thursday, 19 August 2004.

Technical proposals will be opened shortly after closing at the Board's Office in the presence of the bidders who choose to attend.

The Government of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago reserves the right to cancel the bidding process in its entirety or partially without defraying any cost incurred by individuals submitting proposals.
