**PROCUREMENT OF TURNKEY SYSTEM SOLUTIONS**

This invitation for bids follows the general procurement notice for this project that appeared in UN Development Business No. 571 of 30 November 2001.

The Government of Jamaica, through the Ministry of National Security (MNS), has received a loan from the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) toward the cost of the Citizen Security and Justice Program, and it intends to apply the loan proceeds to enhance citizen security and justice in Jamaica. Part of the proceeds of this financing will be applied to eligible payments for the procurement and implementation of turnkey system solutions for the Jamaica Constabulary Force and the Department of Correctional Services. The GOJ's Ministry of National Security is the executing agency for the loan. The Citizen Security and Justice Program will tender on all components of each turnkey solution on behalf of the GOJ's Ministry of National Security.

The GOJ Ministry of National Security (the purchaser) now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the supply, installation and commissioning of each turnkey system solution.

Bidding will be conducted through the international competitive bidding procedures as specified in the basic procurement policies and procedures of the IDB, and is open to all bidders from eligible source countries as defined in the IDB's guidelines. Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information from the address below from Monday, 9 May to Friday, 20 May 2005, from 0900 to 1600 hours (Jamaica time).

A complete set of bidding documents, in English, may be viewed and purchased as of 9 May 2005 at a nonrefundable fee of US\$ 100 or the Jamaican dollar equivalent (which does not cover the cost of delivery). Payment should be in the form of a certified check or bank draft made payable to the Citizen Security and Justice Program.

International bidders may appoint a local agent to purchase the documents on their behalf. Bidders interested in a site visit of the agencies involved may contact the MIS Coordinator at the address below.

Bids must be delivered to the address below no later than 1500 hours (Jamaica time) on Wednesday, 13 July 2005. All bids must be accompanied by a bid bond in a freely convertible currency, in an amount equivalent to no less than 2 per cent of the bid amount. It will not be necessary to submit bids in person since they may be sent by mail or courier. However, the purchaser is not responsible for bids not received thereof on or before the time and date specified for receipt of bids. Late bids will be rejected and returned unopened. Bids will be opened at the address below at 1515 hours (Jamaica time) on Wednesday, 13 July 2005, at a public ceremony in the presence of bidder's representatives, who chose to attend.
