**Abstract: DEVELOPMENT OF WEBSITES AND A PORTAL GATEWAY**

**Loan No. 1344/OC-JA**

This invitation for bids follows the general procurement notice for this project that appeared in *UN Development Business* No. 571 of 30 November 2001.

The Government of Jamaica, through the Ministry of National Security, has received a loan from the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) toward the cost of the Citizen Security and Justice Program, and it intends to apply the loan proceeds to enhance citizen security and justice in Jamaica. Part of the proceeds of this financing will be applied to eligible payments for the development of Web sites and a Portal Gateway for the Ministries of National Security and of Justice. The Ministry of National Security is the executing agency for the loan. The Citizen Security and Justice Program will tender for the services on behalf of the Ministry of National Security.

The Ministry of National Security now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the design, development and installation of Web sites and a portal solution. The successful bidder must also provide training, technical support and maintenance services. Bidding will be conducted through the international competitive bidding procedures, as specified in the basic procurement policies and procedures of the IDB, and is open to all bidders from eligible IDB's member countries.

Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information from the address below as of Monday, 3 October 2005 from 0900 to 1600 hours (Jamaica time).

A complete set of bidding documents, in English, may be examined and purchased from Monday, 3 October 2005 to Friday, 28 October 2005 at a non-refundable fee of US\$ 100 or JMD\$ 6,200 (which does not cover the cost of delivery). Payment should be in the form of a certified check or bank draft made payable to the Citizen Security and Justice Program. International bidders may appoint a local agent to purchase the documents on their behalf.

Bids must be delivered to the address below no later than 1500 hours (Jamaica time) on Wednesday, 23 November 2005. All bids must be accompanied by a bond in an amount equivalent to no less than 2 per cent of the bid price in a freely convertible currency. It will not be necessary to submit bids in person since they may be sent by mail or courier. However, the purchaser is not responsible for bids not received thereof on or before the time and date specified for receipt. Late bids will be rejected and returned unopened. Bids will be opened at 1515 hours (Jamaica time) on Wednesday, 23 November 2005, in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend, at the address below.
