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**GENERAL PROCUREMENT NOTICE**  
**GEORGE PRICE HIGHWAY REHABILITATION PROJECT**

The Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) has approved Loan Contract 3344/OC– BL for BELIZE for a total amount of US\$27 million. Additionally, the EU has approved a total amount of 5 Million Euros. These resources are targeted to finance the rehabilitation of the George Price Highway from mile 47.9 (Belmopan) to mile 67.3 (beginning of Santa Elena bypass) including the replacement of the Roaring Creek bridge at mile 48, which shall be implemented by the Ministry of Works, Transport and NEMO's Project Execution Unit during a period of sixty (60) months. The main objectives of this project are to improve connectivity within Belize and Central America, decreasing travel time and costs, reducing road fatalities and injuries and ensuring road accessibility by improving the climate change resilience of the corridor.

The project's implementation includes Rehabilitation of the George Price Highway from miles 47.9 to 66.1 (Santa Elena) including 2 years maintenance and Replacing of the Roaring Creek Bridge and approaches.

The Specific Procurement Notices (SPN) for pre-qualification and bidding shall be published in local newspapers of wide circulation and on the IDB, and UNDB websites for five years, pursuant to the Procurement Plan published in [www.iadb.org](http://www.iadb.org). Procurement shall include goods, works, services other than consulting services and consulting services for the George Price Highway Rehabilitation Project which will contribute towards the rehabilitation of the road Infrastructure between miles 47.9 in Belmopan and 67.3 in Santa Elena, Cayo District, decreasing travel time and costs, reducing road fatalities and injuries, and ensuring road accessibility by improving the climate change resilience to the corridor. The SPN for pre-qualification and bidding as is the case shall be published according to IDB Policies.
