**Abstract: NEW SANITARY LANDFILL DETAILED ENGINEERING DESIGN**  
**Project GY-0055**  
**Extension of Tender Notice**

This is an update of the notice published in *UN Development Business Online* on 25 July 2003 and in the printed version No. 612 of 16 August 2003. The Environmental Improvement of the Georgetown Interim Disposal Site Project has extended the tender notice to 2 September 2003.

The Inter-American Development is funding the cost of consulting services to prepare the detailed engineering design of a new sanitary landfill for the Georgetown Solid Waste Disposal Program in Guyana (Technical Cooperation No. LO-1052/SF-GY). It is intended that the proceeds of these funds be applied to eligible payments under the project/technical cooperation for which this notice is issued.

The consulting services will consist of:

- Detailed engineering design of a new sanitary landfill
- Elaboration of bill of quantities
- Execution of topographic surveys, geo-technical surveys and soil testing studies
- Execution of an EIA and public consultation (February 2004), and obtaining EPA's approval on the EIA
- Elaboration of tender documents for the landfill construction contract
- Assistance during tender procedures for the construction contract

The estimated cost of the services is US\$ 500,000.

The Government of Guyana (GOG) and the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) now invite interested parties to present their respective documentation for pre-selection in sealed envelopes, with proof of their legal, technical and financial capacity for the provision of the above-referenced consulting services, and following the requirements indicated in the pre-selection documents.

Interested parties may purchase a set of documents as of 23 July 2003, between 0900 and 1400 hours, Monday through Friday, for a non-refundable amount of US\$ 35 or G\$ 7,000 by written communication to the Project Implementation Unit (first address below).

The employer is not responsible for documentation not received thereof, on or before the time and date specified for reception of the proposals, at 0900 hours on 2 September 2003, in which case they will be rejected and returned unopened.

The documentation submitted by the participating firms for pre-selection will be opened at a public ceremony, in the presence of those firm's representatives who choose to attend, at 0900 hours on 2 September 2003 at the second address below.

No more than six pre-selected firms in order of rankings shall make the shortlist.
