Expressions of Interest

The Government of Guyana has received a loan for US\$18.07 million from the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) to implement the Georgetown Solid Waste Management Programme. The general objective is to contribute to improving the quality of life of the population living in Georgetown Municipality and the 15 participating Neighborhood Democratic Councils (NDCs). The purpose of the program is to implement sustainable solutions to solid waste management for Georgetown Municipality and the participating NDCs. It is intended that part of the proceeds of the financing be applied to eligible payments under the contract for which this request for expressions of interest is issued.

The Ministry of Local Government and Regional Development wishes to proceed with the hiring of a consulting firm to execute the following Hazardous Industrial and Healthcare Waste Management activities:

- *A review of the existing situation and current practices
- *Development of a preliminary inventory of hazardous waste
- *Development of a Strategy for Hazardous Waste Management in Georgetown municipality and participating NDCs
- *Implementation of the strategy

The Ministry of Local Government and Regional Development now invites eligible consultancy firms from any member country of the IDB to submit their expressions of interest in no more than ten pages, including details of work in the same areas of specialization.

The estimated level of effort for consultancy is 18 man-months for professional staff. Duration of consultancy is 12 months.

Selection will be based on qualifications and relevant applicable experience. The expressions of interest will be evaluated and the results used to prepare a shortlist of no more than six consulting firms, which will be invited to present technical and financial proposals.

Interested firms are required to submit their expressions of interest by 21 July 2008 at 1630 hours. The employer is not responsible for documentation received after the time and date specified for reception of the proposals in which case they will be rejected.

Application must be submitted in one hard copy and one electronic copy (pdf format) and placed in a sealed envelope, clearly marked at the top left hand corner "Hazardous Industrial and Healthcare Waste Management Consultancy", and addressed to the Project Manager, Georgetown Solid Waste Management Programme, at the address below.
