The Government of Suriname has received financing from the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) toward the cost of the Public Sector Management Strengthening Program, and it intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services in improvement of the Civil Registry.

The services include:

- Revise the current legal and regulatory framework of the Civil Registry
- Revise the operations procedures of the registry and undertake system analysis, develop procedural manual and prepare TOR for a Management Information System
- Develop and implement training program in new procedures for the personnel and setup public awareness campaign to present changes
- Develop and implement the Management Information System, migrate existing records and provide training

The Program Coordinating Unit of the Ministry of Home Affairs in Suriname now invites eligible consultants to express their interest in providing the services. Interested consultants must submit information establishing that they are qualified to perform the services (brochures, description of similar assignments, experience in similar conditions, availability of appropriate skills among staff, etc.). Consultants may associate to enhance their qualifications.

A consultant will be selected in accordance with the procedures set out in the IDB's *Policies for the Selection and Contracting of Consultants financed by the Inter-American Development Bank* (current edition).
