This is an update to the notice previously published in *UN Development Business* No. 641 of 31 October 2004.

The Government of Guyana has received financing from the Inter-American Development Bank toward the cost of the New Amsterdam – Moleson Creek Road. It is intended that part of the proceeds of this financing will be applied to eligible payments under the contract for the construction supervision of the above mentioned Project.

The Government of Guyana, acting by and through the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Public Works and Communications, Wight's Lane, Kingston, invites sealed bids from interested parties, with proof of their legal, technical and financial capacity for the provision of construction supervision services for the rehabilitation of 87 km of road works.

Interested bidders may obtain further information including eligibility to participate and may purchase a set of bidding documents by written communication or by applying in person to the office of the Works Services group, at the first address below, between 0800 and 1600 hours except on public holidays, and on payment of a non-refundable sum of US\$ 40 or G\$ 8,000. Parties who request that the pre-qualification documents be sent to them will be required to pay in advance for this service.

Bids must be placed in an envelope, and marked on the outside at the top right hand corner "Pre-Qualification for Construction Supervision Services - New Amsterdam - Moleson Creek Road". And on the left hand corner the name and address of the bidder.

The envelope should be sealed and addressed to second address below.

Bids must be placed in the Tender Box of the Central tender board at the second address mentioned below at or before 0900 hours, on Tuesday 7 December 2004. It will not be necessary to submit bids in person since they may be sent by mail. However, the Employer is not responsible for bids not received thereof on or before the time and date specified for reception of bids. Late bids will be rejected and returned unopened.

Bids will be opened at a public ceremony in the presence of those bidders' representatives who choose to attend at 0900 hours, Tuesday, 7 December 2004 in the Conference Room of the Central Tender Board, Ministry of Finance.
