The Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) has received financing from the Japanese Trust Fund for Consulting Services (JCF), and it intends to apply part of the proceeds to payments under the project Integrated Management of water resources for the supply of Lima Metropolitan Area.

The objective of the consultancy is to develop specific studies: (i) a study for the optimization of the use of superficial water resources; (ii) ) a study for the optimization of the use of underground water resources; (iii) a study to assess sea water desalinization as a possible complement for the water resources for Metropolitan Lima, and consolidate those studies into an action plan that will drive the water resources strategy of the Water and Wastewater Services Company for Lima.

It is anticipated that the majority of this work will be carried out throughout 2009. More information may be found in the web page:

The IDB now invites eligible consultants to express their interest in providing the services. Since the JCF is a tied fund “the primary providers of consulting services must be consulting firms or individual consultants that are nationals of Japan.” Yet, for the current purpose, it is encouraged that the interested Japanese firms sub-contract firms or individuals that are nationals of an IDB borrowing member country. Interested firms are requested to provide a short summary (maximum 10 letter-sized or A4 pages) of their organization, of water resources management project the firm has lead in the last ten years, and of the firm’s experience in Peru, if any. Consultants may associate to enhance their qualifications.

Consultants will be selected, using a quality- and cost-based selection process, in accordance with the procedures set out in the IDB’s <I>Policies for the Selection and Contracting of Consultants financed by the Inter-American Development Bank</I> (current edition) and the policies of the JCF<sup>1</sup>. Expressions of interest must be delivered via e-mail to the address indicated below by 1700 hours (Washington DC time) on 9 February 2009.
