RESOLUTION DE-89/21

Brazil. ATN/ LC- 18953-BR. Nonreimbursable Technical Cooperation. Low Carbon Agriculture for Avoided Deforestation and Poverty Reduction – Phase II – Strengthening Sustainable Value Chains in the Amazon

The Board of Executive Directors

RESOLVES:

1. That the President of the Bank, or such representative as he shall designate, is authorized, in the name and on behalf of the Bank, to enter into such contract or contracts as may be necessary with the Federative Republic of Brazil, through its Ministry of Agriculture, Livestock, and Food Supply (MAPA), as beneficiary, and with the Brazilian Institute of Development and Sustainability (IABS), as the executing agency, and to take such additional measures as may be pertinent for the execution of the project proposal contained in document AT-1559 with respect to the technical cooperation “Low Carbon Agriculture for Avoided Deforestation and Poverty Reduction – Phase II – Strengthening Sustainable Value Chains in the Amazon”.

2. Such nonreimbursable technical cooperation will be for an amount of up to US\$9,630,000, chargeable to the resources of the Low-carbon Agriculture for Avoided Deforestation and Poverty Reduction Fund – Phase II – as per the terms of the Administrative Agreement signed between the Bank and the Government of the United Kingdom on December 16th, 2016.
