RESOLUTION DE-112/22

Improving the Resilience and Mitigation of Climate Change in Micro, Small
and Medium-Sized Forestry and Agroforestry Companies in Honduras

The Board of Executive Directors

RESOLVES:

1. That the President of the Inter-American Development Bank (the “Bank”), or such representative as he shall designate, is authorized in the name and on behalf of the Bank, as Administrator of the Strategic Climate Fund (the “SCF”), to enter into such agreements as may be necessary for the purpose of establishing a facility, to be administered by the Multilateral Investment Fund (“IDB Lab”), to provide reimbursable financing and nonreimbursable technical cooperation to micro, small and medium-sized forestry and agroforestry companies in Honduras for improving their resilience and mitigation of climate change (the “Facility”) and receive up to US\$10,500,000 from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development, as trustee of the SCF, to fund the Facility, and to adopt any other measures as may be pertinent for the execution of the project proposal contained in document PR-5043.

2. To authorize the IDB Lab’s Donors Committee to approve individual reimbursable operations under the proposed Facility, when SCF resources are used to finance, in whole or part, IDB Lab projects.
