The Government of Guyana has received financing from the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) toward the cost of the Low Income Settlements Programme. It is intended that part of the financing proceeds be applied to eligible payments under the contract for which this invitation for bids is issued.

The Low Income Settlements Programme now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the construction of roads, drains and structures at Parfaite Harmonie, West Bank Demerara, Republic of Guyana.

Eligible bidders may obtain further information (including eligibility to participate) and may inspect the bidding documents at the office of the Low Income Settlements Programme (first address below), between 0830 and 1600 hours as of 3 May 2006.

A set of bidding documents may be purchased by interested bidders on submission of a written application to the same address and upon payment of a non-reimbursable fee of G\$ 10,000. The method of payment will be Manager's check payable to the Low Income Settlements Programme. It will not be necessary to make the request in person to receive a complete set of bidding documents, since these can be sent by mail.

Bids must be accompanied by security of no less than 1 per cent of the bid price and be delivered to the tender box in the office of the second address below at or before 0900 hours on Tuesday, 20 June 2006. It will not be necessary to submit bids in person since they may be sent by mail. However, the employer is not responsible for bids not received thereof at or before the time and date specified for the reception of bids. Late bids will be rejected and returned unopened. Bids will be opened at a public ceremony immediately thereafter, in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend, in the same office.

Bidders registered in Guyana must submit an IRD compliance indicating that they have met their Income Tax obligations for the preceding three years and an NIS Compliance indicating that they have met their obligations for the month immediately preceding the tender.
